Introduction – Overview of the College

Yuvakshetra Institute of Management Studies (YIMS), with the Motto "Inform and Form to Transform" is a premier professional college affiliated to the University of Calicut and managed by the Diocese of Palaghat. YIMS was started in 2005 under the leadership of Rev. Fr. Sebastian Panjikkaran, the founder Director of Yuvakshetra. During its inception, Yuvakshetra was just a vocational training institute. The college expanded its fringes in 2012 by introducing 3 undergraduate programmes. The college also introduced 2 post graduate programmes over the course of 4 years. Without any doubt YIMS has established itself as one of the best Arts and Science Colleges in the University of Calicut. Presently there are seven departments with 13 UG and 2 PG courses. The college has a very good Academic Excellence spreadingquality education and making a remarkable contribution in the field of education. The college keeps pace with the changing world thus acquiring a well-deserved reputation in academics, sports, and co- curricular activities.

The academic year commenced on the 4th of June 2018. The total student strength including the intake during the current academic year for UG and PG programmes is 1652, with 65 faculties and 23 non-teaching staff members.
