



I. INTRODUCTION

Yuvakshetra Institute of Management Studies (YIMS) is an educational project of Yuvakshetra Charitable Trust, Palakkad. YIMS, a premier professional training college in Palakkad is one of the best of its kind in South India. The college was launched in 2005 under the visionary leadership Rev. Fr. Sebastian Panjikaran, the founder director of Yuvakshetra College.

Yuvakshetra Institute of Management Studies (YIMS) was formally inaugurated on December 9th 2004. At its inception, Yuvakshetra was just a vocational training institute. Now, YIMSis affiliated to the University of Calicut and managed by Catholic Diocese of Palakkad. Within a short span of time, YIMS has emerged as one of the pre-eminent higher education centres in Kerala.

Presently there are 10 departments with 14 UG Courses and 4 PG Courses. A total of 723 students were newly admitted in the academic year, 44 more than the previous year.

Our vision is to develop the institute as a centre of holistic excellence for budding professionals, by giving them quality and value-added education to meet the needs and challenges of tomorrow, by attaining intellectual and professional competence for successfully coping with the rapid advancement in technologies and the ever-changing world of business, industry and service. Formation of better citizens, better job candidates, lovers of nature and human beings of values are also part of the vision of YIMS.

Our Motto is "Inform and form to transform". The college focuses on the integral development of each student. Other than subjects of curriculum, Yuvakshetra tries to inform the students about

ethics, values, behaviour and social conduct. The aim of the college is to mould the mind, intellect, behaviour and personality of the students as responsible and potential citizens. The college has developed its infrastructure by adding a new feather to its cap. Jubilee Block was inaugurated by Dr K Mohammed Basheer, Vice Chancellor, University of Calicut on 10th July 2019.

A brief summary of our achievements on the academic, co-curricular and the extra-curricular activities of the year 2020-21 is presented below. The academic year commenced on 1st June 2021 with a total of 2405 students, 75 faculty and 22 staff members.


4 ALUMNI EXECUTIVE MEET 2021- 22


The alumni executive meet 2022 was held on 9th January from 7pm to 8pm. The meet was conducted on online platform zoom.



PLACEMENT CELL

The placement preparation for the students starts off early in the second year for the undergraduates with a training on quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, verbal ability and soft skills training which ensure that the student is prepared for the 1st round of the placement process.
