Untiring Mental Power in a Paralyzed Body Stephen Hawking Challenges Us in our Ordinary Attempts

Stephen William Hawking was an English theoretical Physicist, Cosmologist and author. At the time of his death, he was the director of research at the Centre for Theoretical Cosmology at the University of Cambridge. He was also Professor of mathematics at the same University.

Stephen Hawking was born on 8 January 1942 in Oxford into a family of physicians. In October 1959, at the age of 17, he began his university education at University College, Oxford and completed his BA Degree in Physics with high marks. He obtained his PhD in Applied Mathematics and Theoretical Physics specializing in General Relativity and Cosmology in 1966 from the University of Cambridge. In 1963, he was diagnosed with a motor Neuron disease called amyotrophic lateral sclerosis - ALS that gradually, over the decades, paralyzed him with speechless and the movement of a handheld switch initially and then only single cheek muscle until his death at the age of 76, on 14 March 2018.

Stephen Hawking made his wonderful contributions during his paralyzed and diseased period of 55 years between 1963 and 2018. "Singularities" – 1970 - Stephen Hawking did path-breaking work on singularities and applied it for whole Universe and told that gravitation produces singularities. Laws of "Black Hole Mechanics" – 1971-72 Stephen Hawking discovered the laws of black hole mechanics and in January 1971, he won the prestigious Gravity Research foundation Award for his essay titled "Black Holes". In 1982, Hawking, complementing the inventions of Alan Guth, introduced "Cosmic Inflation Theory" that during inflation it might give rise to the spread of galaxies in the Universe. "A Brief History of Time", that explains about the range of subjects in cosmology

like big bang, black holes, light cones etc. is the Best Seller published in 1988. He is also famous for his Top-Down Theory on Cosmology - 2006.

He also owned several other titles like "Fellow of the Royal Society" and a lifetime member of the "Pontifical Academy of Sciences". He also received the "Presidential Medal of Freedom", (an award bestowed by the president of the US for meritorious contribution to the security or national interests of the United States, world peace, cultural or other significant public or private endeavors). His best seller book, A Brief History of Time writes for the readers who had no prior knowledge of physics and he mentions about the basic concepts of time and space.

Stephen Hawking led a full and complete life, despite his illness, and his scientific work inspired generations of students to study problems of gravity and quantum mechanics. He still continues inspiring aspirants of knowledge and other young people in different ways. His untiring mental strength and scholarship contributed greatly in spite of all his physical uneasiness.

Prepare Yourself for Campus Placements?

Many students do not take campus placement preparations too seriously. However, for most this proves to be a big mistake. We hope that you are not amongst them!

Campus Placement has generally the following stages.

- Skill Assessment Test
- Group Discussion
- Panel Interview Round
- Technical Test
- General HR Round

Skill Assessment is usually an aptitude-based test that helps in determining the reasoning & analytical quotient of a candidate. This test usually consists of multiple-choice aptitude-based questions which need to be solved by a pen on a paper. Skill assessment tests usually consist of a few sections such as communication skills, logical reasoning, quantitative ability & knowledge about your field.

Group Discussion is primarily a campus placement-based exercise. This is an exercise that helps a recruiting manager to analyze each individual during a group discussion & identify their problem-solving abilities as per the situation provided.

Preparing for group discussion during a campus placement drive is paramount. Tips to prepare for a group discussion more effectively are based on the following factors.

1. Be Clear
2. Sharpen Your Communication Skills
3. Take Charge

Panel Interview Round, as the name suggests, is a panel interview round wherein a panel of professional recruiting managers interview a potential candidate face to face. This is more professional than an aptitude or group discussion round. This is the first

time a candidate has one-on-one communication with professionals of a company.

This round determines whether the candidate's application should be moved forward or not. Hence, the importance of this round is much higher. Here are a few ways you can prepare for your panel interview round.

1. Gain Confidence
2. Clarity of Thought
3. Research Well

Technical Round: While preparing for campus placement, candidates usually take researching technical aspects of their domain lightly. However, no matter how good you may be with everything else, if you are lacking the technical field then the chances of you getting through are almost nil. Rather than just relying on theoretical knowledge, you may have gained, make sure that you also read about technological advancements in your field across the world. Deep dive & read about innovations in your field which are used or still are believed to come in near future. Identify the most asked questions & prepare well in advance for such questions.

HR Interview Round is considered to be a basic communication round wherein the HR asks generic questions related to the candidate's resume, tries to understand their personality and gauges if the candidate is a good fit for the company. These may be questions on why the candidate wants to join that organization, what is the salary expectation of the candidate, etc

Candidate can prepare for this round from Common Questions such as

- Tell me about yourself ?
- What are your strengths ?
- What are your weaknesses ?
- Why should we Hire you ?
- Where do you see 5 years down the line ?
- Why did you apply to this position in this Company ?
- Tell your knowledge of this Company?
- What is your Salary Expectation?

- What are you looking for in a new position?
 - Any Questions for us ?
- Campus Placement is considered to be the first leap towards the Future. Hence, make sure you are well prepared for your upcoming campus placements.

General Assembly - II B.Com Finance

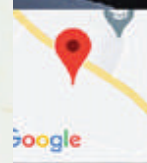

about the Stock Market. The Resource Persons for the session were Mr. Anees K A and Ms. Swathi V A of Final year B.Com Finance B Batch.

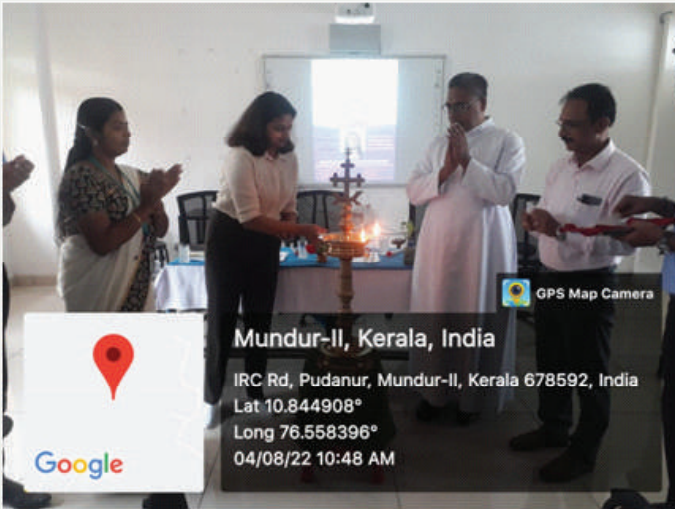
Congratulations to CMA Foundation Winners

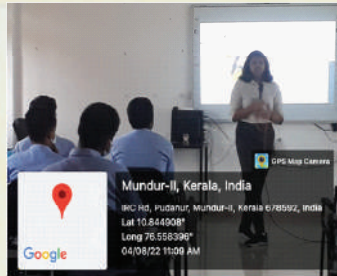

was to give an orientation and induction of new members to Yuvakshetra Family.

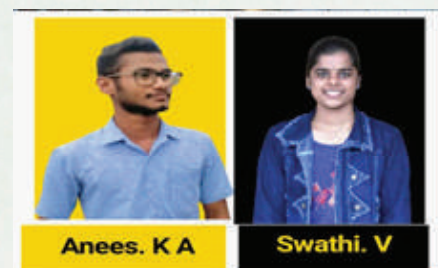

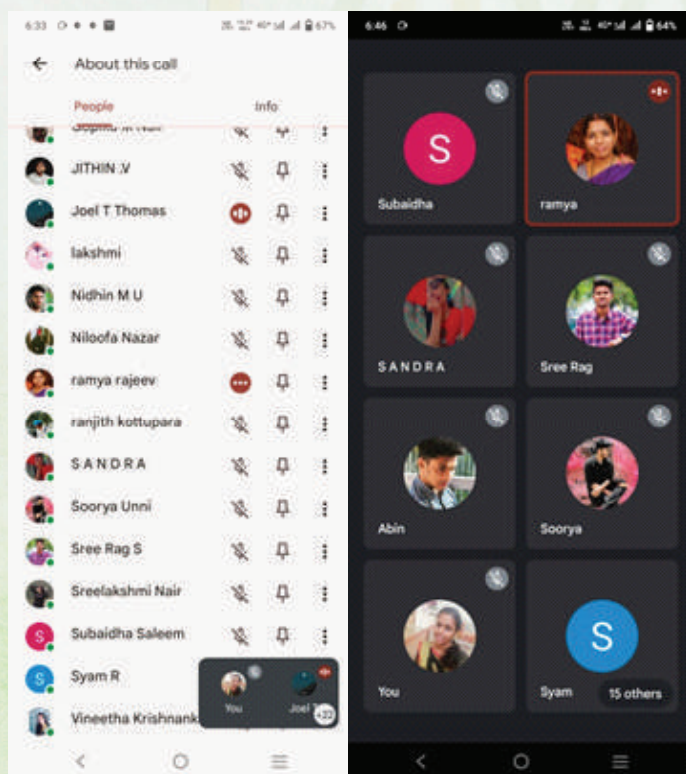

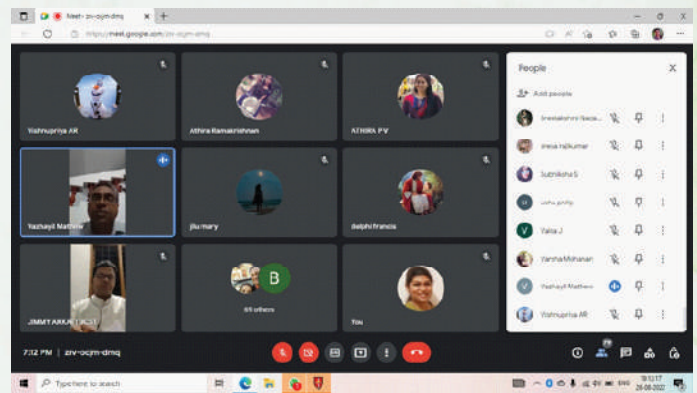


Reconnect – A Trip to Nostalgia

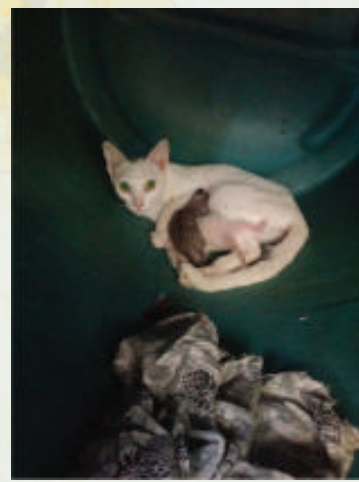

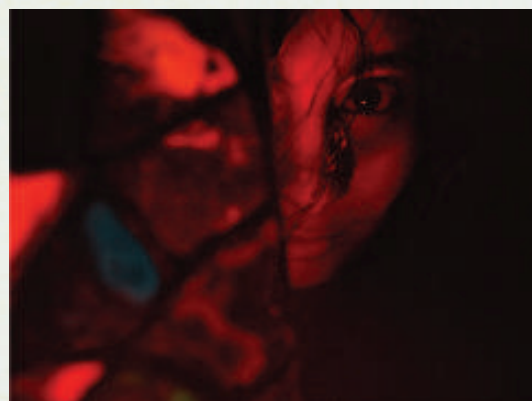

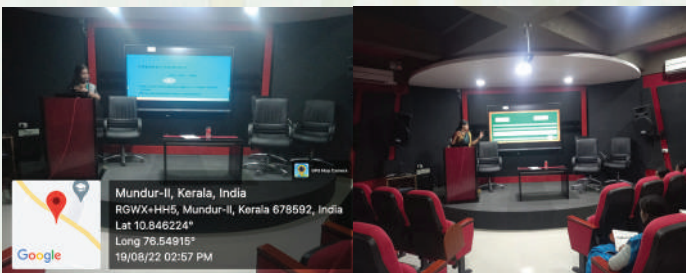
