In 1985, Jobs was forced out of Apple, but later in 1997, Jobs returned to Apple as CEO after the company's acquisition of NeXT. He was largely responsible for reviving Apple, which was on the verge of bankruptcy. He worked closely with English designer Jony Ive to develop a line of products that had larger cultural ramifications, beginning with the "Think different", advertising campaign and leading to the Apple Store, App Store (iOS), iMac, iPad, iPod, iPhone, iTune4s and iTunes Store. He died of respiratory arrest related

to the tumor in 2011, at the age of 56. In 2022, he was posthumously awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom.

Steve Jobs tells "You have to be burning with an idea, or a problem, or a wrong that you want to right. If you're not passionate enough from the start, you will never stick it out". We notice several factors of success in this quote of Steve Jobs and it is closely connected with life and contributions. The first factor that he stresses is 'a burning ides'. It can be either a problem or something that must be made right. The second factor he stresses is the passion from the very beginning. If there is a burning passion from the very beginning of an idea, the goal will be achieved.

Whether we are on vacation or not, let us keep burning ideas within us always, and let us maintain a strong passion from the beginning till the end of the attainment and let us be successful personals and not the mark of failures. 






Two-Day webinar on IPR






