#### Knowledge, Action and Success

(Napoleon Hill) Napoleon Hill (1883 –1970) is best known for his book *Think and Grow Rich* (1937), which is among the best-selling self-help books of all time. Hill's works insisted that fervid expectations are essential to improving one's life. Most of his books were promoted as expounding principles to achieve "success".

Napoleon Hill talks about the two fundamental principles of success such as knowledge and action. We cannot say exactly what is more important between the two, whether knowledge or action. But we are able to say that these two principles are the two sides of the same coin. According to the Dictionary of Oxford Languages, knowledge is the facts, information, and skills acquired through experience or education, or the theoretical or practical understanding of a subject. It also means the awareness or familiarity gained by experience of a fact or situation. While Plato argues that reasoning produces knowledge, Aristotle insists that knowledge is derived primarily from one's senses and the related experiences of one's environment. So for knowledge, there is always an internal dimension which will be made perfect with the experience.

The Collins Dictionary defines action as doing something for a particular purpose. In Philosophy, an action is an event that an agent performs for a purpose that is guided by the person's intention. The first question in Philosophy of action is to determine how actions differ from other forms of behavior. Action involves a movement for the attainment of something, memorable and rewarding.

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Strategies for Digitalisation and Marketing of Select Geographical Indicated Tagged Products

Indications, Geographical component Intellectual Property Rights, are the signs that identify the goods originating from a specific geographical location and possess the fundamental characteristics from the place of origin. The promotion and marketing of GI Tagged products play a critical role socially, economically, and culturally. It creates a significant impact in eradicating poverty and developing rural areas. GI is Tagged to the products possessing exotic quality attributes from tradition and history, enabling producers and artisans to command premium prices. Reputation and regional origin created more demand, and consumers' willingness to pay high premium for the product. However, even though a law under IPR was enacted for Geographical Indication, India has been inefficient in using GI Tags and lacked postregistration activities. Recently, GI registrations have been higher, but the producers claim lower income due to a lack of post –registration activities. Therefore, the study made an attempt to develop distinct Strategies for the Digitalisation and Marketing of Geographical Indication (GI) Tagged Products in the select region.

The research study was carried out from the perspectives of both GI Producers and Consumers. The GI producers' perception of adopting digitalisation, current promotional techniques, awareness, usage, implementation of digitalisation, opportunities, challenges of digital platforms, organisational readiness and problems faced by them in the marketing of GI products were discussed. The total sample producers were classified into Digital Adopters and Non – Adopters. From the consumer point of view, the intention to purchase GI products online was studied using

The methodology adopted is a survey where the producers involved in GI production of products registered from April – 2004 to March – 2022 and consumers who purchased at least one GI product of Kerala were considered. Stratified proportionate sampling technique as used to identify 400 GI producers and snow ball sampling was adopted to choose 400 GI consumers from North, Central and South Zones of Kerala.

The analysis showed a positive intention among the consumers to adopt digitalisation for GI product purchases. The non-adopters showed a positive attitude in implementing digitalisation for the marketing of GI products in future. Based on the study's other findings, strategies and suggestions were developed to help the producers to market the GI products effectively. Increased marketability results in commercialisation which create millions of employment opportunities, uplift various ancillary units and develops the socio – economic condition, thereby resulting in rural development. Further, adopting the formulated strategies strengthens the marketability and aids in achieving the mission of Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan.


